1. What prevailing themes exist throughout the *Three Sisters Trilogy*? List examples that support these themes.
2. What events and which people shaped Sadie Larkin's evolution from a lone survivor to the leader of a successful revolution?
3. What qualities do José and Caleb possess that make them such an integral part of Sadie's success. How have their responsibilities and roles affected them?
4. How does Sadie's and Caleb's relationship evolve? What factors shaped their transition?
5. Extreme disparities exist between civilian survivors of the Tri-nami/Global Flood and the Splitter Nation. What factors created, and then continued that divide? What societal disparities and divides are prevalent today?
6. Throughout the trilogy, Sadie trusts her gut instinct and surrounds herself with a team based on those feelings. Which of these characters, did you relate to the most and why?
7. Have you ever encountered a situation or a person that evoked a strong instinctual gut response? Did you follow that feeling? Why or why not?
8. What are the defining moments in the transition of Rene's and Sadie's relationship?
9. Caleb and Rene are continually at odds with one another until the very end. Did you foresee this change in their dynamic? Why or why not?
10. After reading the *Three Sisters Trilogy*, have you adopted any changes in your lifestyle? If so, what are they and why?
