Book Club Questions

1. How did the novel's timely theme of a world set in a post apocalyptic environmental disaster make you reflect on the current problems we are facing today?
2. Do you think this vision of a post-apocalyptic society is realistic? How far are we from sliding towards this vision?
3. Why do you think no one challenges Sadie's authority? What do you think the key elements were to her attaining such respect?
4. There is a great deal of tension between Caleb and Sadie based on their past. Do you feel they can overcome this tension? Why or why not?
5. What character do you relate to the most? And why?
6. Do you think there is a specific reason why all four of the characters came together? How do they help each other heal and grow?
7. Each character seems to play a certain role in a family structure. How did they fill the space for each other's losses?
8. There was a great deal of trauma, violence and brutality in the new society. How do you think these realities formed and changed the characters?
9. People had to arm and prepare themselves with survival skills. How do you imagine you would adapt to this situation? Do you think you would be able to survive under those conditions?
10. What do you think Sadie has planned for the people she would like to bring back to the Three Sisters? What do you imagine their lives would be like?
